

Mr. Radio (Chris Rasch) grew up in East Germany, and has been out and about as a multi talented full-blooded acoustic player for the last 30 years playing folk & rock, americana, westcoast, southern blues, celtic, country and bluegrass styles.

Solely with acoustic guitars, dobro and mandolin, he plays interpretations of the "take your hat off to him" variety with a lot of his own songs and many different musical influences. For friends of handmade music the songs will be put in long term memory straight away through his own style, his routine handiwork, his one of a kind voice, and all that in the unplugged trend of today.

Despite having toured as a professional musician with other projects as front man with some bands Wild Eagle (D), Heartland (D), Celtic Colours (B/D/UK), Simple Song (D), Rubber Duck (D), Jerico Bee (CZ/USA) he never let the anonymousness of the "lone Ranger" be taken from him, again and again going back to the roots with new solo paths at festivals, concerts, town venues, industrial events and all sorts festivals. For small stages not too big and for big stages not too small.

His uncountable appearances at festivals in Europe and the USA, his own productions, and his work on other CD's not only as a guitarist but also as a singer and composer have led to the development of his non-typical style. Through his openness for other cultures and influences he has achieved a strong stylistic creativeness that have allowed him to go new ways.
